School Routines

Learning in Year 2

Literacy

- We will continue with phonics and spelling rules in Year 2
- A range of writing genres will be explored and high quality texts have been selected to model to the children.
- Please can you encourage your child to use joined cursive handwriting at home whenever they are writing.

<u>Maths</u>

- Year 2 use 'Maths no Problem' which is a structured programme to ensure all areas are covered to promote maths mastery.
- We use resources, pictures and formal methods to deepen children's understanding and fluency.

Curriculum

We teach PSHE, R.E., Guided Reading, P.E. Phonics and Topic (Science, History, Geography, Art, Music and ICT) weekly in a
variety of ways including outdoor learning, visitors, trips and online.

Homework

Reading

- All children are expected to read a book at least 3 times a week at home. There will be regular assessments in school to monitor whether children need to
 move to a different coloured book.
- Children can change books themselves. If they want to change their books can you ask the children to put their reading folder in the red box and we will
 ensure they have an opportunity during the day to change them.
- We visit the library once a week where the children can explore their interests. This half term our library day is Tuesday.
- Reading records need to be in school EVERY day.
- Every child reads every day in their phonics lessons and we aim to read with your child on a separate occasion every other week.

Spelling

- Each Friday children will bring home their spelling homework for the week.
- We follow the Spelling Shed scheme and we will learn the spelling rules during our Literacy lessons.
- A spelling test will be done each Friday so children are expected to have practised them on the sheet. This identifies which words and spelling rules we need to revisit and is as informal as possible. These will start after half term.
 - Please ensure your child does practise spellings as we are monitoring their progress.

Maths

- Each Friday children will bring home their maths homework for the week.
- This will be linked to the area of maths we are learning about that week.

Homework

Topic

At the end of a term, we might send some homework to do over the holidays, including lots of different activities linked to the next topic.

Children can pick 3 or 4 of these activities to complete over the holidays and share with the class when they come back to school.

Times Tables

By the end of Year 2, children are expected to know their 2, 5 and 10 Times Tables as well as the division facts. We will also introduce counting in steps of 3, 4, 6 and 8 in preparation for Key Stage 2 in Summer 2022.

Additional Support

Some children may have additional resources sent home to support their learning in school. We would appreciate parent/carer support at home to reinforce the children's learning.
